### KINGS MATRIC SCHOOL GETS STATE SWACHH VIDYALAYA PURASKAR AWARD FOR CLEANLINESS

## JUNIOR, MIDDLE & SENIOR OPEN DAYS

On 11th August, the open day for the classes VI to IX was held in their respective classes. Nearly 95% of parents turned up for the day. Every parent met the respective class teachers and the subject teachers to know their wards academic results and activities in the class. The class teachers handed over the Mark sheets to the parents and they gave valuable suggestions in the learning schedule of the children. A few parents met the Academic Supervisors



and Section Head as well. The open day for the classes of I to V and X to XII was held on the same day in their respective classes. Nearly 90% of parents came to the school to collect their children's report card in Junior school. In the Senior school nearly 80% of parents came to the school to collect their children's report card. The teachers shared their valuable suggestions to the parents and the parents clarified their doubts with them as well.



## PUBLIC EXAM RESULTS 2018

Results of the final examinations of Classes X, XI and XII were announced by the Tamilnadu Government Education Department during the month of May. Kings School secured a 100% pass rate in classes X, XI and XII. These are fantastic results from all students who worked hard, but this would not have been possible without the hard work and total dedication of the staff who gave their time unstintingly to the students.

### CLASS XII

The results of the Tamilnadu HSC (Std XII) exams were released on 16th May. Ahamed Shafana M, a student in Commerce - Business Maths scored 1179 out of 1200. Sahibha Hithaya Y, scored 1171 and came second, Mercia A scored 1160 and came third. 8 students of our school scored above 1150 marks and 11 students scored between 1100 and 1149.

### CLASS XI

The Tamilnadu Board has announced Class XI board examination results on May 30th. It was a tough year for all students as the board exams were happening for the first time for class XI; they worked hard and passed with flying colours. Thomas Mary Jerlin J, a student in Commerce-Business Maths scored 564 out of 600 and came first. Mohamed Akram stood second by scoring 549 and Jency Devi.N scored 546 and came third. 11 students

of our school scored above 500, 21 students scored above 450 marks and 32 students scored above 400 marks.

### CLASS X

The Tamilnadu Secondary School Leaving Certificate (SSLC) exam results were declared on Wednesday, May 23rd. Among the Students who appeared for the Class X exams, Jesi C scored 490 out of 500. Kavya K and Nilahni N shared the second place with a score of 488 and Ranet Susmita S D came third with 484 marks.

## STUDENTS MOTIVATION PROGRAMME

On 14th July, the students of classes VI to XI had a motivation programme organised by Oxford University Press, Chennai. Prof. Jesudoss, the resource person talked to the children on Teenage, adolescence, study techniques, goal setting, value of education and staying focussed.





## AN AWARENESS SEMINAR ON CAREER CHOICES

On August 25th a general career choices programme was organised for the children of class IX at the Burden Centre. Nearly 150 students participated the program. The program commenced with the welcome speech by the Principal followed by the Power Point presentation of Mr. Alwin, career guidance co-ordinator. He made a fine gesture by mentioning the importance of the students in choosing their career in their most interested areas and asked them to focus on the same field. He further showed them the 4 steps in choosing careers like Self-assessment, Career Exploration, Decision Making and Taking Action. He also briefed a few points about, what children should not do

in choosing their career then explained about 'Intelligent impact career choice'. Its definition and its kinds such as linguistic intelligence, logical & mathematical intelligence, musical intelligence, spatial intelligence, interpersonal intelligence, intrapersonal intelligence and naturalised intelligence.
